# ATELIERFRANKFURT

The Residence Program of ATELIERFRANKFURT e.V.

guest @ ATELIERFRANKFURT is a fellowship program designed to bring young and upcoming, international artists to Frankfurt as a major financial center and introduce to them its cultural life. Sponsors (banks, companies, law firms) support a *guest* to stay in Frankfurt and work in a studio at ATELIERFRANKFURT for a period of six months, during which the artist will be able to work in Frankfurt. The results of his/her work will be presented in a show at the end of the stay.

ATELIERFRANKFURT is a platform for the production and presentation of various areas of art. With 40 studios, two exhibition halls, a lecture room, cafeteria and club-room, it offers an exchange of contemporary trends in Frankfurt, the Rhine-Main region, Germany and abroad.

Since its foundation in 2004, guest artists came to ATELIERFRANKFURT: starting with Clayton Deutsch (New York), Ninna Korhonen (Finland) and Wilma Ehni (Peru), of which some now permanently reside in Frankfurt. guest @ ATELIERFRANKFURT establishes this exchange project as a permanent program to benefit foreign artists and the city of Frankfurt.

## Terms

- **SELECTION** A *guest* is selected by a jury of three experts from the contemporary art world
- **BENEFITS** The *guest* will obtain a studio (approx 20 m<sup>2</sup>) at ATELIERFRANKFURT and a cost of living allowance of EUR 400 per month. ATELIERFRANKFURT will assist in finding an apartment and provide other assistance to facilitate transition
- **EXHIBITION** At the end of his/her stay at ATELIERFRANKFURT, the *guest* will present his/her work made during the project in an exhibition, accompanied by a catalogue
- **CONTRIBUTION** The proceeds of any works done at ATELIERFRANKFURT and sold during the project will be shared by the *guest* with ATELIERFRANKFURT
- **SPONSORING** The sponsor who supports the *guest* will be referenced in the catalogue. A preview of the exhibition will be done for the sponsor's clients and/or employees, where the *guest* should be present
- **COMMUNITY** During the project, the *guest* is welcome to form part of the community of ATELIERFRANKFURT. Annually, ATELIERFRANKFURT opens its doors to the public for the *Rundgang*, where the *guest* is expected to participate with an informal presentation of the studio. The guest is bound by the terms of ATELIERFRANKFURT's lease agreement
